

DIRECTIONS FOR OBTAINING THE MIDDLE CHILDHOOD GENERALIST ENDORSEMENT AT THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY

The School of Teaching and Learning at The Ohio State University offers a Middle Childhood (MC) Generalist Endorsement that allows candidates who are licensed to teach two subject areas in grades 4-9 to add licensure to teach all subject areas in grades 4-6. To fulfill the requirements for the endorsement, candidates must successfully complete at least two courses (minimum nine quarter hours) in each subject area being added to the initial license, a methods course in each subject area, and the appropriate PRAXIS II specialty area exam(s). Candidates must have received or be on track to receive a standard Ohio teaching license for two Middle Childhood subject areas to be eligible to apply for the MC Generalist Endorsement. Candidates who received teaching credentials from another state and need information about obtaining equivalent licensure in Ohio should contact the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) at 614-466-3593 or visit the Web at <http://www.ode.state.oh.us/> to request an out-of-state application and information packet.

Step 1

Schedule an appointment with an academic advisor in the School of Teaching and Learning on any of the five campuses:

The advisor will approve your enrollment in the MC Generalist Endorsement program and start a program file on your behalf.

Step 2

Fill out the “Middle Childhood Generalist Endorsement Enrollment” form and submit it plus a copy of your transcript or advising report and a copy of your teaching license or confirmation of your enrollment in a teacher licensure program to the Office of Academic Services as soon as you are cleared by an academic advisor to begin the endorsement coursework:

Step 3

Successfully complete the content and methods courses for the licensure areas to be added as listed on the “Middle Childhood Generalist Endorsement Program Sheet” with a minimum 2.7 GPA in each area and at least a “C” in each course. ***Both methods courses must be completed at OSU.*** Content courses taken at other institutions ***may*** be approved after faculty review of a detailed course description or syllabus. ***Unless otherwise approved by the faculty, all coursework must be completed within ten years of applying for the MC Generalist Endorsement.*** Any substitutions for the required course work must be approved by the faculty coordinator. To request a substitution, submit a petition, a copy of your transcript or advising report, and a syllabus or detailed course description to the Office of Academic Services (OAS) in 227 Arps Hall. Petition forms are available in the academic advising offices.

Step 4

Pass the appropriate PRAXIS II specialty area test(s). You may take either the Middle Childhood specialty area tests or the Elementary specialty area test. Check the ODE Web site at <http://www.ode.state.oh.us> to confirm that you are requesting for the correct test. Search for “Praxis II Tests,” then click on “PDF outlining ODE’s Praxis II testing information for Ohio teachers.” Registration information is available on the Praxis Web site at <http://www.ets.org/praxis>. Have your scores sent to The Ohio State University (reporting code **R1592**). Allow approximately 6-8 weeks for the results to be posted to your student transcript.

Step 5

Upon successful completion of all required course work, submit the “Middle Childhood Generalist Endorsement Clearance Sheet” and a copy of your OSU advising report to the **Endorsement Coordinator, Office of Academic Services, 227 Arps Hall, 1945 N. High St., Columbus, OH 43210**. Once you have been cleared for licensure, a copy of the approved endorsement sheet will be forwarded to the College’s Licensure Officer.

Step 6

Submit an application for licensure and a check or money order for \$10, made payable to **Ohio T.E.C.**, to Licensure Officer, College of Education and Human Ecology, 350 Campbell Hall, 1787 Neil Ave., Columbus, OH 43210. (If you are applying for initial licensure and the endorsement at the same time, the fee is just \$24.) Applications are available on the ODE Web site at <http://www.ode.state.oh.us/>. As soon as PRAXIS scores have been received by the University Registrar, your application for licensure will be approved and forwarded to ODE with your check or money order.

Advice to Student:

If your contact information (phone number, address, email) changes, please notify the Office of Academic Services to ensure that you receive updates about the program.
