Official Rules

Any currently enrolled Ohio State University at Lima student may enter. Each student will compete in one of Levels I or II, according to which college mathematics courses he or she has successfully completed, and will compete only against other students in that level.

Level I: Math 050-116, 130, or 148, but no higher.

Level II: Math 117, 131, 132, 150, or higher.

Within each level, three prizes worth a total of \$225 will be offered:

First prize	\$100
Second prize	\$75
Third prize	\$50

These prizes will be gift cards redeemable at the campus bookstore (or, any Follett store).

A set of four questions will be posted by 9:30 AM each Monday, April 6, 13, 20, and 27, in room 310 Galvin.

Students may attempt any and all questions.

Each problem solution must be on an official entry form including your name and a complete explanation of your solution. Entry forms may be obtained in the **Heath Learning Center**, room 310 Galvin Hall.

Contestants may refer to any textbook, but may not consult with any other person for the solutions.

Solutions must be submitted to Patricia Johnson in 310-E Galvin by 4:00 PM no later than eight days after they are posted.

Once a solution has been submitted, it may not be changed. Multiple solutions by one person will be disqualified. Each question will be graded all or nothing. Judges' decisions will be final.

Prizes will be awarded subject to sufficient response. No prizes will be awarded by default.

Winners will be announced by Friday, May 8, 2009.
