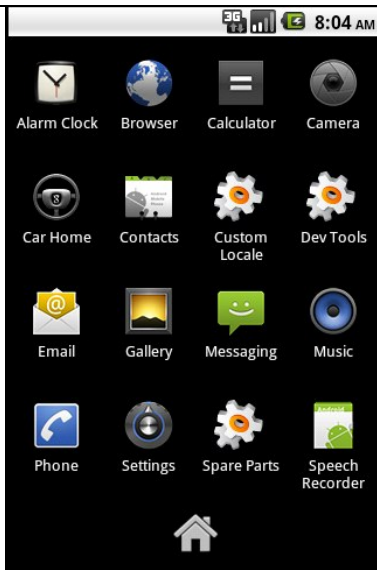
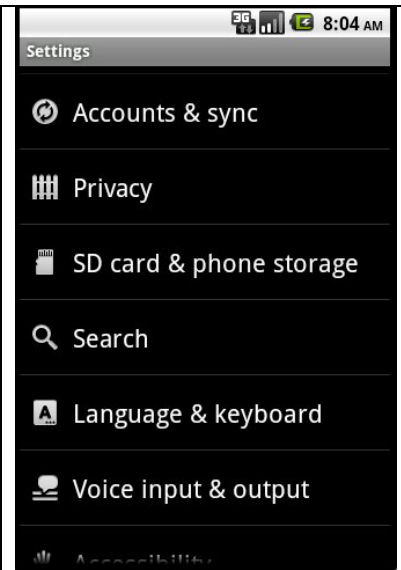


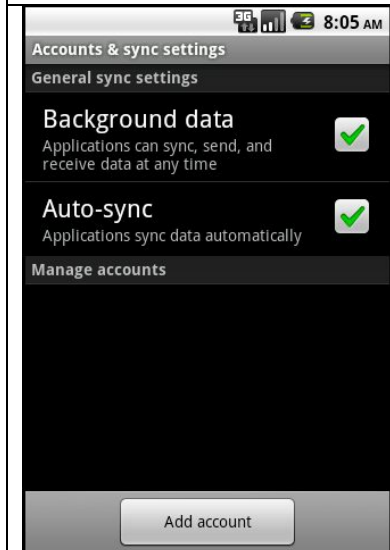
1. Select the Launcher



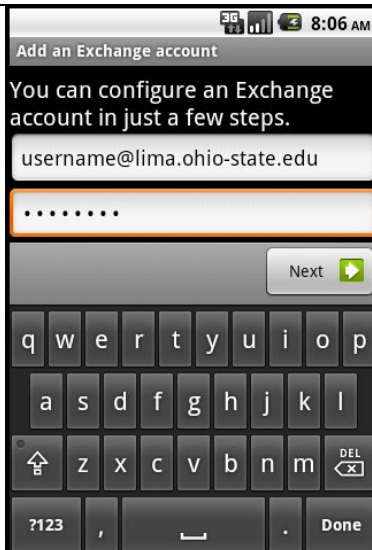
2. Select Settings



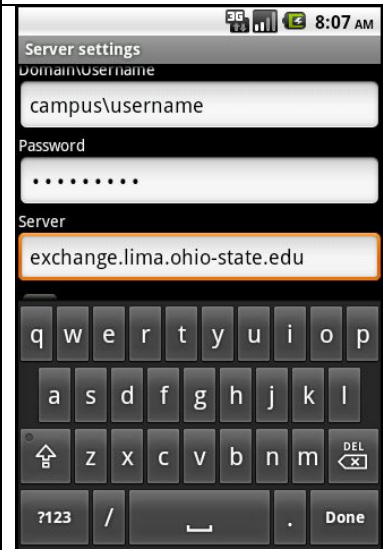
3. Select Accounts & Sync



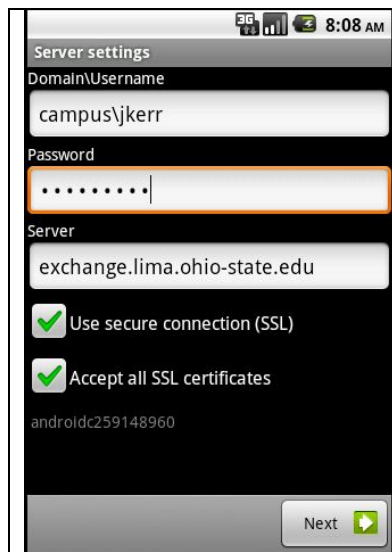
4. Select Add Account



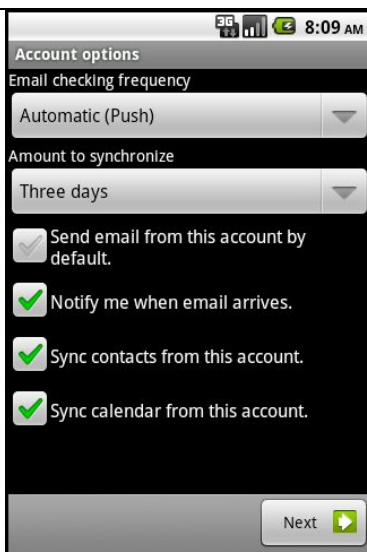
5. Enter your Lima e-mail address and password, then select Next



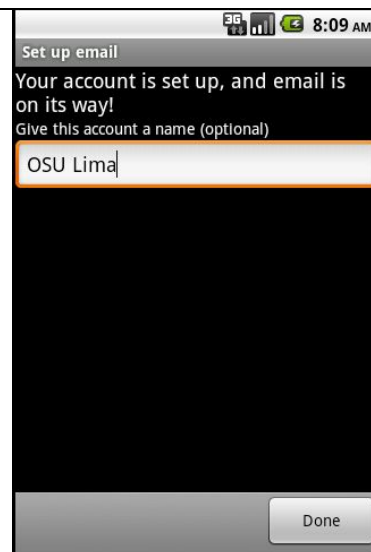
6. When prompted, add *campus* to your username, so it is entered as *campus\username*, and add *exchange* to the Server name, so it is entered as *exchange.lima.ohio-state.edu*



7. Select the two SSL options so they are turned on.



8. Select options as desired. Checking frequency determines how often it receives messages. Automatic (Push) means every new message received will also be received on the phone, and will notify you. Other options check at regular intervals, all the way to manual refresh only, which only checks for messages when you run the e-mail application. The more frequently it checks or receives messages, the more data your device will use. This may have an impact on your cell phone carrier costs if you use any data plan other than unlimited data.



9. Give the account a name, and select Done. You should now be able to see your Lima messages, contacts, and calendar entries as they exist on the Exchange server.
