



# K-12 Mild/Moderate Special Education Licensure

The Ohio State University at Lima has developed coursework towards a K-12 Mild/Moderate Special Education Licensure program to enhance and diversify teaching skills at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. To receive licensure by completing the program of study, students must already have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and a current state of Ohio teaching certification or license. Exchange of Service schools may qualify for discounted rates.

All courses are 3-credit hours, except course 8189, which is a 4-credit hour course.
