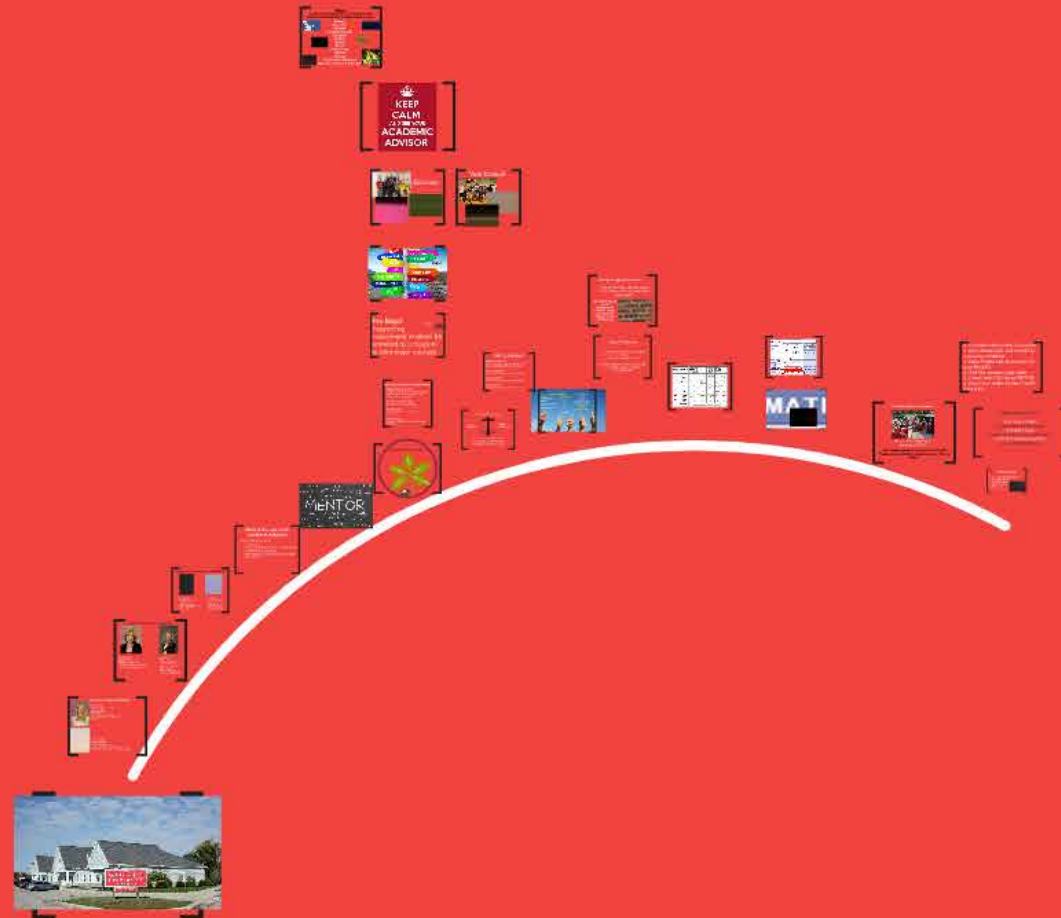

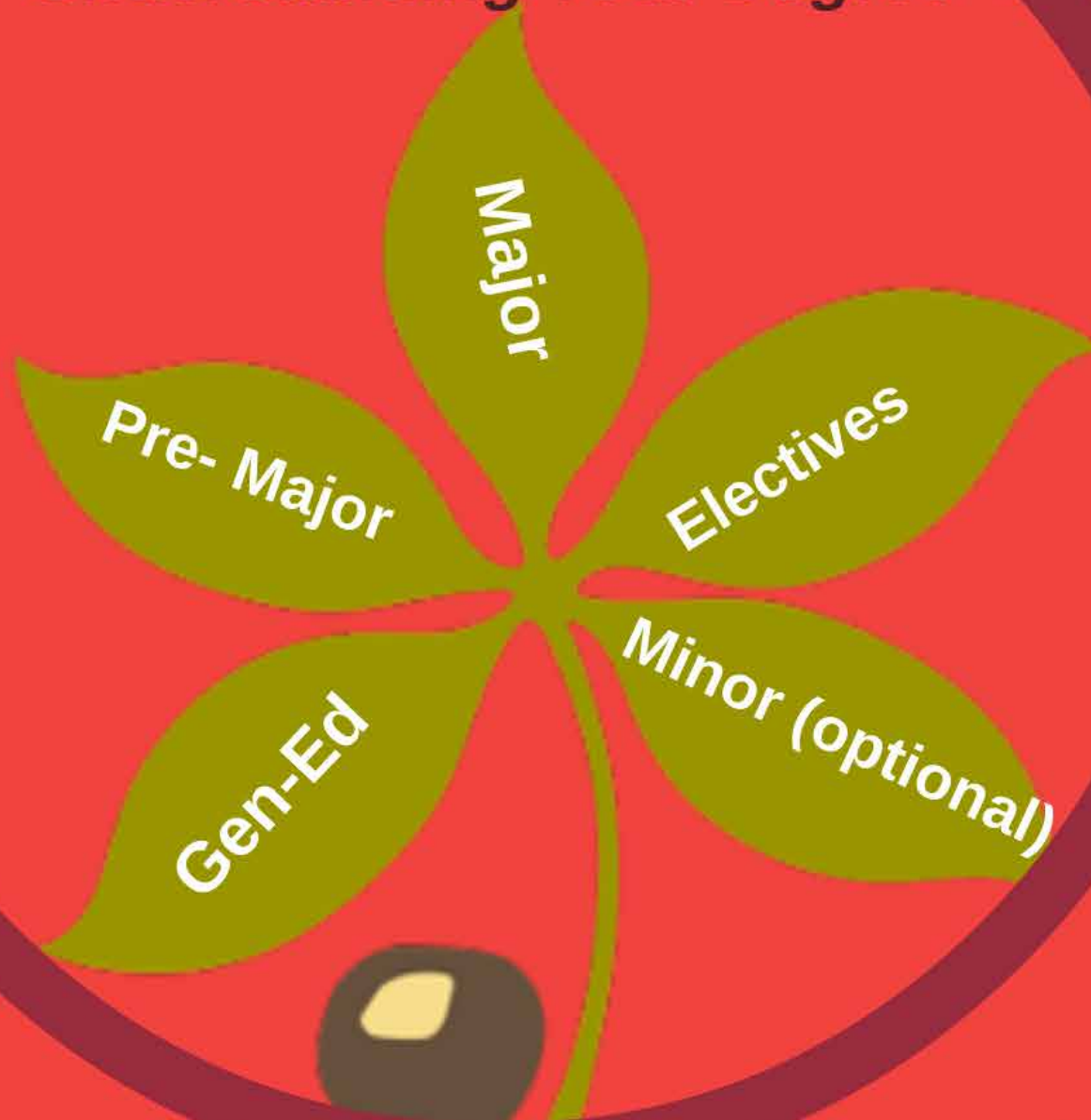
What is the role of an Academic Advisor?

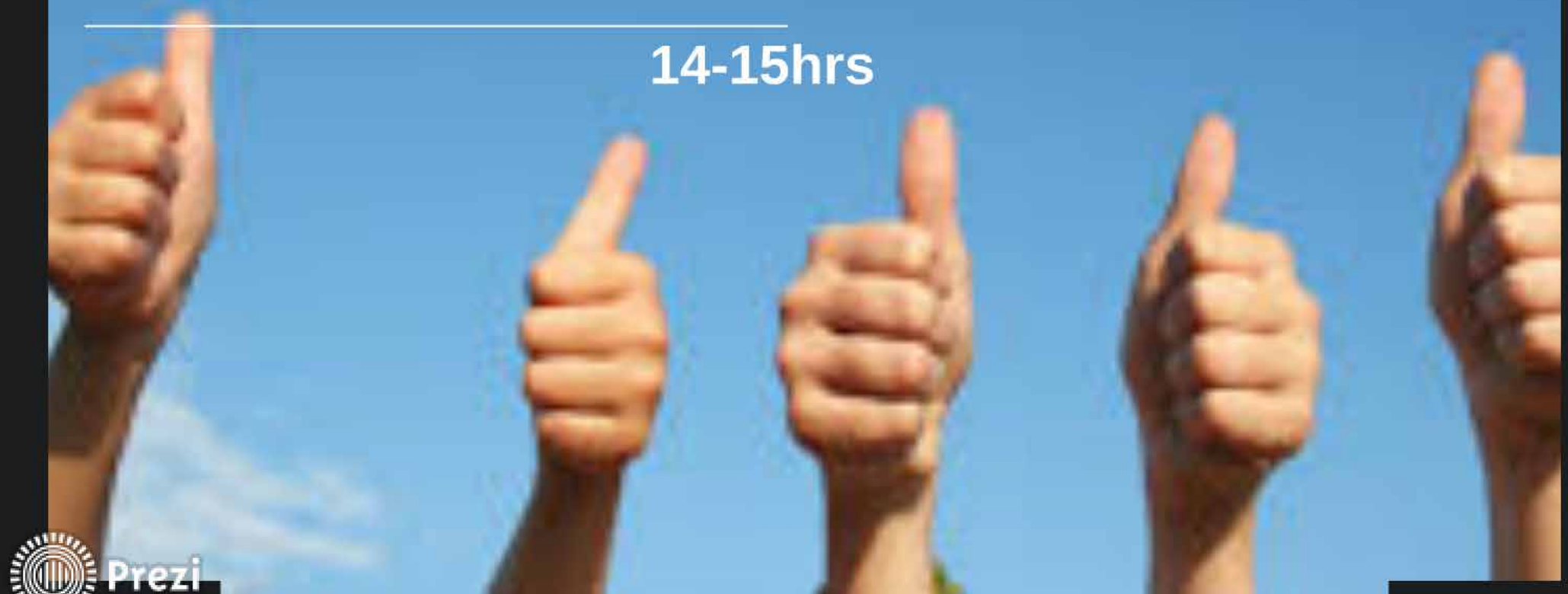
