RESEARCH INTERESTS

I study how and why people revise possible selves and core selves in response to social feedback-- the social negotiation of self. My research attempts to account for self-revision across two interrelated: (1) The Psychology of the Changed and (2) The Psychology of the

Changer. The first line of inquiry explores how and why someone would revise a self-view in response to social feedback, whereas the second explores how and why someone would ever try to change another person's self-views. Most recently, I have begun to explore the relations between self-revision process and fluctuations in mental health and well-being.
