AP	PLICATION PROCESS (October-January)
	 Compare what it will cost to go to college at the schools you're interested in. Visit <u>studentaid.gov</u> to apply for a Federal Student Aid ID (FSAID) for you and your parent. These allow you and your parent to sign the FAFSA. FSAID: student parent Visit <u>studentaid.gov</u> to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be considered for federal and state aid. Complete the FAFSA after October 1 of your senior year (deadlines vary by school)*. Your tax data
	can automatically be transferred to the FAFSA form. (Ohio State Federal School Code: 003090) Date FAFSA submitted** 4. Complete the Ohio State Application for Special Scholarships online via ScholarshipUniverse
	 (osu.scholarshipuniverse.com) between December 2022 and February 15, 2023. 5. Apply for all Ohio State Lima scholarships (if you meet the eligibility requirements) via ScholarshipUniverse. Osborn Family Scholarship, and/or Griffith Family Scholarship.
	6. Apply for your chance to earn a full or half tuition scholarship through the Rudd Scholars program. Apply via go.osu.edu/limascholarships7. Continue to search and apply for private scholarships.
	 Community and civic organizations and through your employer Receive notice that your FAFSA has been received and processed. Receive your federal Student Aid Report (SAR) based on the FAFSA with your Expected Family Contribution.
AC	CEPTANCE PROCESS (January-April)
	 10. Congratulations! You have been admitted. Colleges will now begin offering you estimated financial aid award packages (grants, work-study, loans and scholarships). 11. Compare aid packages offered from various colleges. 12. Decide which college you want to attend and accept your package, if required. Pay your acceptance fee by May 1. 13. Turn in additional documents to colleges/universities (tax returns and university documents), as requested.
FIN	IAL STEPS (May-August)
	 14. Did financial aid cover 100% of your financial need? If not, you should consider working part-time, borrowing if needed, using college payment plans, or other options to pay your balance. 15. Before school begins, complete your required online Federal Direct Loan Entrance Counseling and sign your Master Promissory Note (MPN) for your loans (studentaid.gov). 16. If you were awarded work-study, search for a job on campus. This allows you to earn a paycheck while enrolled. 17. You are off to college — CONGRATULATIONS!!
